### North Scottsdale Democrats Voter Guide

ELECTIONS ARE DECIDED BY THOSE WHO VOTE!

#### PROPOSITIONS

**Prop 133 - NO**

Effectively forbids open primaries and outlaws ranked choice voting; supersedes city authority

**Prop 134 - NO**

Makes it harder for citizen initiatives to qualify for the ballot

**Prop 135 - NO**

Removes the ability of the Governor to quickly respond to a crisis; limits Governor's authority

**Prop 136 - NO**

Weakens citizen initiative process by allowing lawsuits before the initiative goes to ballot

**Prop 137 - NO**

Greatly weakens judicial merit and retention system by effectively removing voters' ability to deny retention of judges

**Prop 138 - NO**

Allows restaurants and bars to pay sub-minimum hourly wage as much as 25% less for tipped employees

**Prop 139 - YES**

**Restores AZ constitutional right to abortion care!**

**Prop 140 - NO**

Eliminates partisan primaries; requires ranked choice voting; gives too much power to state legislature to decide winners

**Prop 311 - NO**

Creates new state fund to administer limited death benefit for 1st responders killed on duty, gives too much control over fund surplus to state legislature

**Prop 312 - NO**

Allows property tax refund for nuisance; overrides city authority

**Prop 313 - NO**

Unnecessarily amends existing sex trafficking laws; mandatory life sentence removes discretion in sentencing

**Prop 314 - NO**

Makes undocumented border crossings a state crime; allows arrest by state/local police and deportation by state judges

**Prop 315 - NO**

Changes rulemaking; legislative ratification; regulatory costs

#### City of Scottsdale

**Prop 490 - YES**

Protects our parks and the Sonoran Desert Preserve. Extends existing tax that is expiring, but at a lower rate.

**Prop 491 - YES**

Not a tax, this measure simply increases the city's spending limit to cover increased costs. Last adjustment was 18 yrs ago.

#### Maricopa County

**Prop 479 - YES**

Continues the existing, dedicated half-cent sales tax for transportation (formerly prop 400)

**Prop 486 - YES**

Expand & strengthen educational opportunities within Maricopa County's Community Colleges in place since 1989
